The Young Marines is a youth leadership program for youth (ages 8-18) modeled after, and officially endorsed by, the United States Marine Corps. The Northern Kentucky unit is a group of amazing young people who have joined this program in order to become better citizens, great leaders and examples of integrity for their peers. These motivated youth go through mandated training and must pass written, oral, and physical tests in order to become a proud member of the Young Marines. Our Young Marines meet every other Saturday and they work on physical fitness, public speaking, close order drill, military and American history, rank structure, and much more. Our unit is 1 of over 240 units across the United States and internationally.

This program is one of the only (if not **the** only) youth-led, merit-based programs. These kids are leaders; they work hard to earn their rank and billets through discipline, teamwork, and hard work. The Young Marines work year 'round to prepare themselves not only for each drill, but for leadership billets, Leadership Schools, and promotions. They act as Color Guard for many Veteran and community events, march in parades to honor veterans, go on encampments, teach Drug Resistance in our communities, and set a great example of how youth should act, work, and respect our military members.

We hold multiple fundraisers each year including our Birthday Ball every October, modeled after the Marine Corps Ball, where we celebrate our past year, recognize individual YM achievements and honor the adult volunteers who freely give of their time to help the next generation of leaders. We are seeking donations (gift cards, product donations, event tickets, hotel stays, etc.) in order to fund leadership and learning opportunities for our Young Marines.
