The Young Marines is a **Leadership Program** for kids ages 8 through the completion of high school modeled after, and endorsed by, the United State Marine Corps. At our unit (one of nearly 240 across the U.S.) we focus on Military & American History, physical fitness, public speaking, citizenship, community service, and living a healthy, drug-free lifestyle. Young Marines are not pushed into the military, but they are required to appreciate the freedoms granted by those who serve.

The Northern Kentucky unit currently has 14 active Young Marines and 5 volunteer Adult Staff members. Our YMs march in parades, perform Color Guard duties for military and veteran events, go on encampments, earn rank, improve their physical fitness, study American and military history, volunteer their time with many organizations, and commit to healthy, drug-free lifestyles. **We were just selected as the Division 2 Unit of the Year and are now 1 of 6 units in the running for 2023 National Unit of the Year.**

We are currently striving to send our Young Marines to Honolulu to participate in the memorial remembrance of the attack on PEARL HARBOR. Participating Young Marines will be taking part in community service activities while on the island of Honolulu, from cleaning up beaches to wreath-laying ceremonies. These Young Marines will also take part in the Pearl Harbor Day Memorial Parade, where they will march and carry banners to represent the ships that were attacked, as well as participating in memorial services to honor the lives lost. They will also tour Pearl Harbor historic site, where they will be given the chance to interact with survivors of that dark time in our history.

These Young Marines have committed to work hard to demonstrate they will take full advantage of learning ahead of time so that they will appreciate all that they experience even more. Furthermore, they will bring it back to their unit and communities in the Tri-State area to continue to enhance one of their most important missions: Veteran Appreciation. Any contributions will help cover the airfare, ground transportation, and accommodations. The Young Marines will work to raise their own funds for uniforms, activities, gear, and meals.
